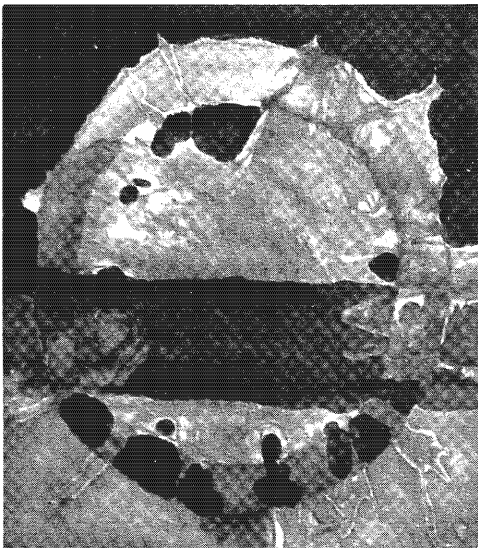

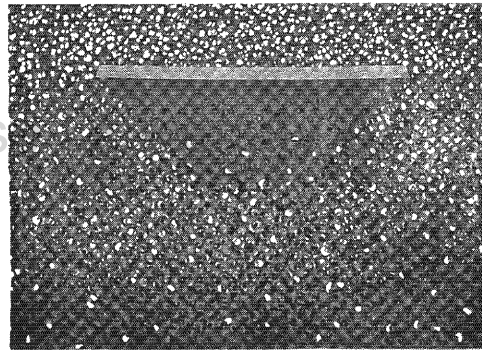

Laurie Zagon was educated at Maryland Institute College of Art and Syracuse University where she received her B.F.A. and is a candidate for an M.F.A. degree.

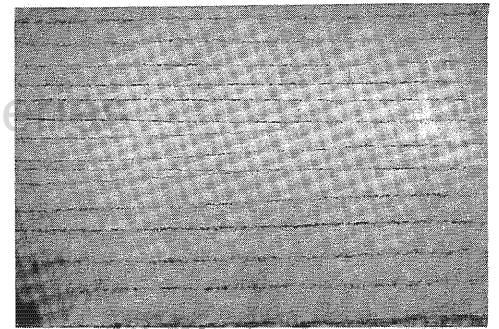

Anthony Schneider was educated at the Maryland Institute College of Art and Syracuse University where he received his B.F.A. and is a candidate for an M.F.A. degree.

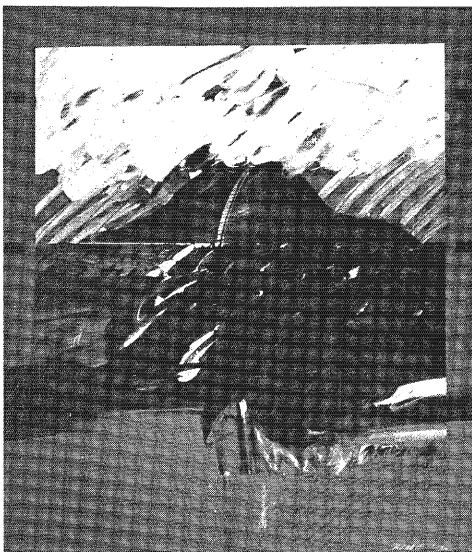
